# St Hugh's Cross-country Relays 2011

On Tuesday 8 November the weather was kind for the first time ever at the St Hugh's Relays which was good news for our runners for their first competitive outing of the year. The slight drizzle was complemented by mild temperatures, and even the course at St Hugh's was not quite as muddy as usual. It is a short one, only 1000m for the U8 and U9, and 1300m for the U10 and U11, but it is tiring and contains a vicious slippery hill which saps the strength out of legs. Then the runners have to negotiate an awkward section along the edge of a recently planted field, which was heavy going with the tracks holding large puddles of water. With our current crop of runners there is quality spread throughout the age groups, and expectation was high, which added to the pre-race excitement and tension, and the reality did not disappoint. There were, once again, some high quality running schools present including strong teams from the hosts, and it was soon evident that we were going to have to be at our best to gain good results. This is exactly what all our teams did, which is now the norm for any runner who has gained selection for a Beachborough running team, and the effort and commitment was there in spades. Due to this our results are once again an improvement on last year's, and an indication that there are plenty of strong runners still coming up through the younger years. The U9, U10 and U11 Boys' teams all managed to secure an excellent 3<sup>rd</sup> place in their races, the U9 Girls went one better to grab 2<sup>nd</sup>, but the main honours once again went to a superb victory by the U11 Girls (Siena Robbins, Scarlett Jewson and Zoe Pollock), who have now won for 3 years in a row. Well done to all the runners for such determined and focused performances on the day.
