Art & History Trip to London

The VIth Form went on an Art and History Trip to London on Thursday with Mr. Southwick, Mr. Sanders and Ms. Agutter. In the morning they visited the National Army Museum for a lecture and weapons handling session which encompassed the experiences of various types of soldiers during the English Civil Wars. This enabled the children to expand on their existing knowledge by gaining greater insight into the period. The benefit of this will be to help them with their studies in the next two terms. The children then explored various other galleries discovering different aspects of the history of the British Army through the ages. After a packed lunch supplied by

the ladies in the Kitchen - for which they were most grateful- they visited the National Gallery where there was a talk on various paintings through time culminating in a fascinating discussion of Seurat's bathers.

BEACHBOROUGH CHARITY POOL PARTY **Saturday 19th March.**

Our main fund-raising event this term will be a 'Pool Party' at Towcester Leisure Centre.

We are planning to run 2 sessions:

Session 1: Nursery - Form II pupils 4 pm - 5.30 pm

Session 2: Form III - Form VI pupils 5.30 pm - 7 pm

Both pools have been booked exclusively for the 'Beachborough Pool Party Swimmers.'

Swimmers will be able to enjoy using the flume (height 1.2m or above), play in the waves or have fun swimming with their friends using a selection of different floats. Also, during Session 2, the large inflatable will be available in the Competition Pool.

SUPERVISION:

There will be lifeguards supervising each pool and the flume.

If your child is Under 4 they will require an adult to swim with them at all times.

If your child is aged 4 years to 7 years we will require 1 adult for every 2 swimmers in this age bracket.

If your child is 8 years or over and can swim at least 25m, adult supervision in the pool is not necessary.

There will be members of Beachborough Staff to supervise all 'Pool Party Swimmers' when they leave the Changing Rooms to enter the pool-side at the start of their session and then at the end of the session 'Pool Party Swimmers' will need to sign out. All children must be accompanied by an adult at the sign-out point before they leave the Leisure Centre.

You are welcome to bring other friends and family members; the same supervisory requirements are necessary.

TICKETS for this event will cost £5 for each child per session.
