## Swanbourne Chase 2011

This year's Swanbourne Chase actually took place in relatively balmy conditions compared with the normal freezing rain, sleet and bitter wind. The course was also in good condition, although the runners looked at the hills and stiles with some trepidation as usual before the start. We were missing a couple of runners through illness, and several of those present had only recently recovered from a variety of ailments which had caused a lack of serious preparation, but they all set off in good spirits as the sun tried to break through. The first hill was a bit of a shock to the system to those lacking miles in their legs, but by the last long hill zigzagging up the playing fields all the Beachborough runners had settled into their stride and finished strongly, many making up several places on the run in to the finish. A really good effort was displayed by everybody, despite the problems suffered over the last month or so, and our results were very solid in all 4 races, against very high class opposition who take their running very seriously indeed. Pick of the individual performances from Beachborough was in the U13 Girls' race, where Emily Chamberlain finished in a very strong 7<sup>th</sup> place in a highly competitive event. Best team performance goes to U11 Girls, who finished in 4<sup>th</sup> place and included 4 girls from Form III in the team of 6, which bodes well for next year. ## **BEACHBOROUGH CHARITY POOL PARTY** **Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> March.**

Our main fund-raising event this term will be a 'Pool Party' at Towcester Leisure Centre.

We are planning to run 2 sessions:

Session 1: Nursery - Form II pupils 4 pm - 5.30 pm

Session 2: Form III - Form VI pupils 5.30 pm - 7 pm

Both pools have been booked exclusively for the 'Beachborough Pool Party Swimmers.'

Swimmers will be able to enjoy using the flume (height 1.2m or above), play in the waves or have fun swimming with their friends using a selection of different floats. Also, during Session 2, the large inflatable will be available in the Competition Pool.

### SUPERVISION:

There will be lifeguards supervising each pool and the flume.

If your child is Under 4 they will require an adult to swim with them at all times.

If your child is aged 4 years to 7 years we will require 1 adult for every 2 swimmers in this age bracket.

If your child is 8 years or over and can swim at least 25m, adult supervision in the pool is not necessary.

There will be members of Beachborough Staff to supervise all 'Pool Party Swimmers' when they leave the Changing Rooms to enter the pool-side at the start of their session and then at the end of the session 'Pool Party Swimmers' will need to sign out. All children must be accompanied by an adult at the sign-out point before they leave the Leisure Centre.

You are welcome to bring other friends and family members; the same supervisory requirements are necessary.

**TICKETS** for this event will cost £5 for each child per session.
