Malawi was the first country to receive Mary's Meals. We have been serving children here since **2002** in close collaboration with the **Government of Malawi**. We have also joined forces with local partner **MCSPA** to deliver in-school feeding in difficult-to-reach areas.

Mary's Meals operates in most regions of Malawi and our programme feeds almost one third of all primary school-age children in the country.

We are currently feeding 1,043,455 children.

We feed in a total of **1,011** primary schools and Early Childhood Development Centres across Malawi.

A typical school meal consists of **maize or soya porridge** boosted with minerals and vitamins, known locally as '**likuni phala**'.


